Publication catalogs

- **THE figure of merit for our facilities**
(Former director general of ESRF months of his life)
- **BUT badly treated: seems to be at the end of any project**
(typical: EDNP)
- **Even worse: grey literature (PhD's, technical reports)**
- **Obvious advantages:**
 - ❑ Reporting
 - ❑ EU annual reports
 - ❑ Dynamic highlight web info (popular abstracts, postprints, beamline efficiency, publication records for proposals ...)
 - ❑ Totally novel options for more aggressive PR on all levels
- **Example from PSI DUO:**
 - Practically ready since 5y
 - Politically not ripe
 - Used first time for Annual Report in 2008

Publications, a top EU-wide Issue

Main Ideas

- **Minimize input effort -> ISI (Thomson Reuters) queries**
 - ☐ Decentralized data input by authors (save our secretaries)
 - ☐ User friendliness: Reduce alpha input to the **absolutely necessary**, (e.g. one author name + year), rest by clicking
 - ☐ Avoid ambiguities + typos
 - ☐ Solve “et.al.”-problem
- **Handle remaining issues with publication tool**
 - ☐ Correlate ISI authors with names in local user database
 - Solve ISI author – institute correlation problem
 - Solve „Mueller“ problem
 - ☐ Optional input of popular abstract
 - ☐ Optional input of postprints (**By the way: EU-wide solution of open literature problem!**)
- **Only needed: federated user database**
