Publications, a top EU-wide Issue

Publication catalogs

- THE figure of merit for our facilities (Former director general of ESRF months of his life)
- **BUT** badly treated: seems to be at the end of any project (typical: EDNP)
- > Even worse: grey literature (PhD's, technical reports)
- Obvious advantages:
 - Reporting
 - EU annual reports
 - Dynamic highlight web info (popular abstracts, postprints, beamline efficiency, publication records for propsals ...)
 - Totally novel options for more agressive PR on all levels
- Example from PSI DUO:
 - Practically ready since 5y
 - Politically not ripe
 - Used first time for Annual Report in 2008

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Main Ideas

- Minimize input effort -> ISI (Thomson Reuters) queries
 - Decentralized data input by authors (save our secretaries)
 - User friendiness: Reduce alpha input to the **absolutely necessary**, (e.g. one author name + year), rest by clicking
 - Avoid ambiguities + typos
 - ☐ Solve "et.al."-problem
- Handle remaining issues with publication tool
 - ☐ Correlate ISI authors with names in local user database
 - Solve ISI author institute correlation problem
 - Solve "Mueller" problem
 - Optional input of popular abstract
 - Optional input of postprints (By the way: EU-wide solution of open literature problem!)
- Only needed: federated user database
